



Sample Teacher Grants

Teachers Center seminars held in St. Augustine for 3 years have generated several interesting projects approved for teacher grants.

- One teacher grantee developed traveling trunks with materials and lesson ideas for students learning about the history of our nation's oldest European settlement.
- Another educator engaged the actor who portrays a French survivor of the Matanzas massacre to present his piece for 5th – 8th graders who learned about the European powers' contests for Florida.
- A Pensacola teacher applied for a project modeled after the St. Augustine program and organized a tour for students with archaeologists to learn the history of their home town.

Other projects involve students hearing from Freedom Riders about their experiences in the Civil Rights movement, students visiting cultural centers to learn first-hand about different religious traditions, and multi-cultural projects that explore the various cultural traditions of students' families.
